Schedule:

The Greenville Head Start class meets Monday through Friday from 9am-1pm from September through mid-June. The daily schedule includes group and individual activities in science and exploration, dramatic play, math, literacy, music and movement and art. Children play outside each day weather permits and breakfast and lunch are included.
