Head Start is a comprehensive child development program designed to foster the healthy development of preschool children and their families.

Child Development Services:

- Quality preschool education to promote school readiness skills;
- Ongoing developmental screening and assessment to meet the varying needs of children;
- Activities to build social and self-help skills.

Health & Nutrition:

- Work with families to address special health and nutritional needs;
- Provide healthy meals and snacks;
- Health & nutrition screenings.

Family Services:

- Parenting support and education;
- Parent involvement opportunities and social activities;
- Support with access to needed community services.



The Nashua Child Development Center provides a number of program options to meet family needs.

- Head Start preschool program which offers a morning session that meets 4 hours per day, Monday through Friday from September through mid-June.
- Head Start preschool program with wrap around child care is available for parents who need full time care
- Full day child care for children ages 3-5 years
- Infant/Toddler care serving children 6 weeks -3 years

Staff:

The staff of the Nashua Child Development Center have degrees in Early Childhood Education, preschool certifications and early childhood coursework as well as ongoing training in their field. They have many years of combined experience working with young children and their families.
