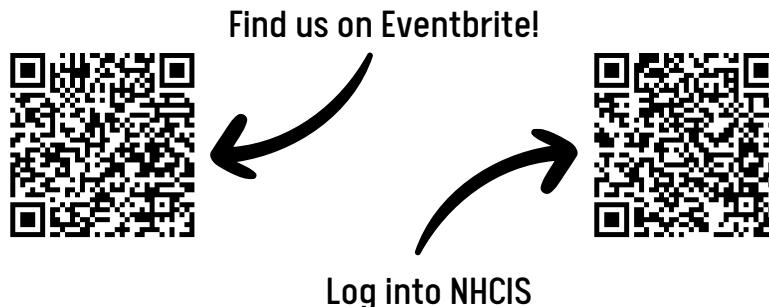

4. You can view trainings in three (3) formats: by list, week, or month
  - a. Use "Week View" or "Month View" to register (registration CANNOT be completed in "List View")
5. Click the title of the training and then the blue "Register" button
  - a. If the training is offered multiple times, please click on "Sessions" to register for your intended date

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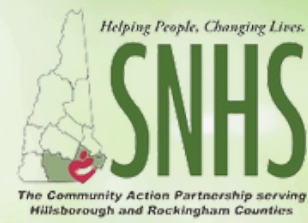
